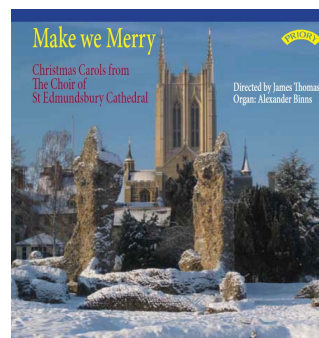
Guided Tours
