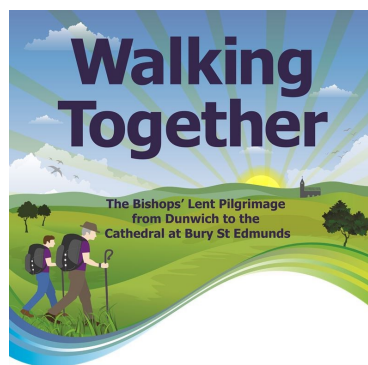




Weekday Service Changes
