## Clerestory Work

Work has started on repairs to the nave clerestory.

This plus work to the cloister roof and library roof is being funded by a £350,000 grant from the Government's First World War Centenary Cathedral Repairs Fund.

Canon Precentor at the Cathedral, the Rev Canon Philip Banks said: "This work will complete a number of major works for the current generation and we envisage there will be no more major work needed for over 100 years."
